Short Nose = open minded, optimistic, outgoing individuals. Dislike detail and perform their work on the basis of emotional impulses. Works best when given encouragement



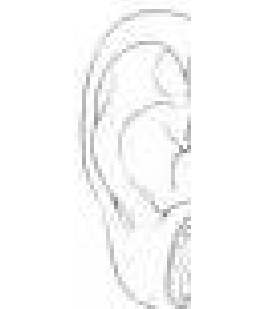
